Checked Bags: Yes (Special Instructions) Power tools must be packed in checked bags, including drills and drill bits. Power tools with installed batteries must be packed in checked bags. ...

Damaged, defective or recalled lithium batteries must not be carried in carry-on or checked baggage. Additional information concerning recalled consumer batteries and battery systems may be located ...

Since some devices use lithium ion batteries, you cannot travel with them in your checked bags. You can travel with them in your carry-on, but you're not allowed to use them on board any flight.

If you are bringing power tools any spare or loose lithium-ion batteries cannot be packed in checked baggage and must be packed in carry-on bags. If a power tool has an installed lithium ...

Yes, you can bring power tool batteries on a plane as long as they are properly packed in your carry-on or checked luggage.
