The Desert Sunlight Solar Farm is a 550-megawatt (MWAC) fixed-tilt photovoltaic power station approximately 6 miles (9.7 km) north of Desert Center, California, United States, in the Mojave Desert. It was made by the US thin-film manufacturer First Solar but now has split ownership between NextEra Energy Resources, Clearway Energy, and California Public Employee's Retirement System (CalPERS). The power plant is capable of generating 1,060GWh of electricity a year, which is sufficient to serve 160,000 homes in California and equivalent to offsetting 300,000t of carbon dioxide emissions a year ...

The \$2.2 billion Ivanpah solar power project in California's Mojave Desert is supposed to be generating more than a million megawatt-hours of electricity each year.

While the first U.S. solar plant, built in 1982, generated 1 megawatt of electricity, Desert Sunlight generates 550 megawatts. Topaz produces the same amount. Together their impact on ...

At project completion, 8.9 million solar modules will have been installed at the project. Desert Sunlight is expected to generate 1,060,000 megawatt-hours of clean energy per year while preventing 614,000 ...

The desert sunlight solar farm (also known as desert sun solar farm) was built in two phases: the first phase was built with a capacity of 250 MW, and the second phase was built with a capacity of 300 MW.
