



How long is the warranty period for the base station backup power supply

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Back-UPS warranties can be extended to a maximum total of 6 years (3 years Factory Warranty + 3 years Extended Warranty). Batteries separately purchased will only have a 2 year warranty and will not ...

The warranty period for home power backup systems can vary depending on various factors. However, there are some average warranty periods that are commonly offered by manufacturers.
